Please consider this as a letter of reference for Kevin McClain. I have worked with Kevin and his firm for the past six years, I have the highest regard for him professionally and personally.

I am a career criminal defense attorney. I owned my own firm for 23 years. Thereafter, in 2003 I joined the full time Clinical faculty of this law school and formed what is now the *Center for Criminal Defense*.
